Active Monitoring

SensiGuard Services actively monitors shipments, events, and locations from origin to destination using embedded tracking technology and the management of pre-defined security protocols. Before a shipment leaves the dock, a tracking device is embedded at the pallet level and “activated” for monitoring by our SensiGuard Global Command & Control Centers.

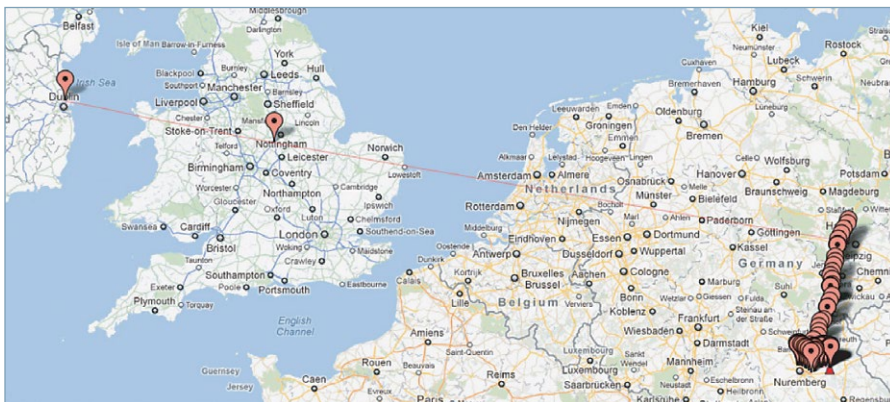
While monitoring shipments, the C3 can alert deviations in real time related to location, motion, light, and temperature—all factors that can indicate a threat to the integrity of a shipment. And threats are measured beyond the cost of a stolen load; loss of product integrity could expose an organization, and its customers, to significant risks such as loss of sales, public relations, investigation, and insurance.

Our robust active monitoring process also includes:

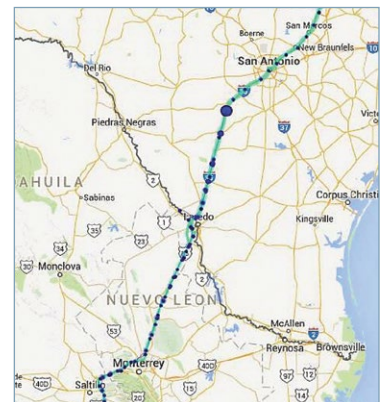
- Pre-determined georoutes designed to utilize low-risk lanes
- Driver departure interviews
- Cargo departure and arrival confirmations

- Notification alerts of geofence breaks or violations of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
- A designated program manager provides operational and compliance metrics, such as carrier patterns, risk propensity, and shipment-level performance evaluations
- Actionable alerts received deviating from a pre-determined security plan; the Global Command & Control Center is notified and an investigation is initiated immediately. Situations include: route deviation, unauthorized stops, and early departures and delivery.
- Georouting is used to create a virtual fence around a shipment once the safest route is established; if a deviation is detected, notifications are launched immediately and SensiGuard C3 escalates a resolution process.
- Theft Recovery begins during the escalation process; SensiGuard C3 works with local authorities across the globe to recover the shipment in its entirety.
